- Communication with the construction team in a timely manner.
- Verifies and records corrections for non-conformance in the field.
- Enter field data into the survey database.
- Ensure housekeeping in and around the survey office.
- Inspect, calibrate, and maintain survey equipment.
- Complete additional duties as required.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Possess a safety-oriented mindset.
- Physically capable of lifting up to 50lbs and installing survey stakes in a variety of terrains.
- Physically capable of spending most of the day walking/standing and carrying survey equipment.
- Familiar with a variety of survey layouts, construction, and as-built surveys.
- Ability to work independently, take initiative, and solve problems.

- Ability to perform calculations in the field.
- Strong literacy skills include the ability to read and understand design work points.
- Effective interpersonal and communication skills (verbal and written).
- Ability to work under pressure and maintain effective time management.
